I will be shutting down the survey at the end of this month in order to begin data analysis so this will be the \_last\_ announcement for participation. I will make the results of the study available to the BCACC as soon as my dissertation is complete. I hope that the report will be useful to BCACC members and will persuade other groups to take steps to improve the safety of their members as the BCACC has.
