

## Health Management Program (HMP) Information:

The HMP ( <http://www.sfubusiness.ca/hmdp/> ) was originally developed in a unique collaboration between St. Paul's Hospital (now under Providence Health Care) and Simon Fraser University's Faculty of Business. Already early on, in keeping with best practice, the program has been open to all clinical professionals to foster interdisciplinary leadership development and over the years the program has attracted many physicians, nurses, fellows, medical technologists etc. from across British Columbia, including BC Ambulance Service.

The aim of the HMP is to prepare clinicians for senior administrative and leadership roles within the health care system. Feedback on the quality of the program has indicated that this objective has consistently been met through the program's 4 modules. Participants find the program invaluable and increasingly recognize the need for a foundation in leadership and management learning and development to participate fully in the decisions regarding health care delivery and leadership. The next program launches on September 16, 2010.
